Letter From Our Board Chair

The enduring challenges brought about by the pandemic have continued to have major impacts on our community, and most importantly, our children's lives have been affected in ways we are still grappling with as we develop our youth for their own future. Despite this constantly evolving and challenging year, 2021 turned out to be a truly remarkable and impactful time for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Bend. I'm optimistic for a brighter future for our organization and our Club kids.

As I prepared to step into the role of Board Chair in December 2020, I knew our organization would face adversity and obstacles never experienced before, and for the sake of our Club kids and families we serve, failure was not an option. As I reflect on the year and the ups and downs we've experienced, the challenges were not unlike those we faced over the past 25 years. The time for changing the trajectory of our Club is now, and I'm excited to share with you the results of the hard work from this talented and dedicated Board of Directors and loyal staff of our Club.

In 2021 alone, from hiring an interim executive director, to overseeing the nationwide search for our next Club CEO that will lead us to a brighter future, to recruiting a dedicated Board of Directors, to navigating the evolving pandemic challenges - all while ensuring we met the needs of our Club kids and families - I feel proud of what we have accomplished together. Last year, our Clubs, staff and Board continued to step up as schools shut down. We found ways to thrive alongside our Club members, despite the constant changes to regulations and mandates to ensure public health and safety. In 2021, we served 263 kids and supported more than

\$254,000 in scholarships for families who needed us most.

Not only did our Clubs provide a safe, engaging space for our children to learn and grow in self discovery, but we also played an instrumental role in supporting families returning to work, which drives our economy forward. When parents and guardians know their kids are safe and secure, our community can return to work. We couldn't have accomplished our mission so quickly without the help of many of you, our supporters and champions, who recognize the need for after-school and summer school-aged programming. I'm proud of all we accomplished collectively in 2021 as a Club community.

The first 25 years of our organization might have been known for struggling to keep our doors open, and although the road ahead will continue to have challenges, our Club is positioned to embark on our next 25 years with a goal of blowing open those doors to better serve our community and our Club kids. Together, and in service of our Club and community, I am embarking on my second year as Board Chair, and I can't wait to see what 2022 and beyond will bring us.

Letter From Our CEO

Without a strong network of adults who helped me discover my passions and talents, I wouldn't be who I am today. A love for reading, for writing, and for tutoring and teaching bloomed in me because my support system encouraged me, challenged me, and told me that my choices, passions, and dreams were possible. Not all of my peers had that kind of support; not all of my peers found success, and not all of my peers are still with us today. I worked hard and had a drive to achieve, but more than that, I was lucky and privileged and loved. I am who I am today and I'm able to snowshoe and stand-up paddleboard in the beauty of Central Oregon because I had adults who believed in me - in my potential - when I was six, twelve, and eighteen years old in rural North Carolina. That's what drove me to this role, to lead the Boys & Girls Clubs of Bend as CEO.

I believe in our kids, especially those who need us most, and when I interviewed in April 2021 to take the helm, I could feel the commitment, love, and vision from our Club's team and board. The pandemic has been incredibly challenging, y'all; more challenging for us all than a few brief words in this note can express. But I think about the kids who need us most - and their families - and I know that this pandemic and all its surges have most likely hit them hardest. In these trying times, our Club has shown up time and again. I stepped into this role in July 2021, and even in those six short months that closed out 2021, I saw so much.

I saw our team support our Club members in academic success, healthy lifestyles, and character and

leadership development. I saw our team create safe spaces to nurture the kids in our community by helping them learn how to cope, how to express, and how to connect. I saw our kids show kindness to each other, and celebrate the wins of individuals and groups. I saw our kids discover new interests, develop a love for reading, and embrace new life lessons. I saw our community of champions, from community-based organizations to local businesses and foundations to engaged individuals - step up and step forward to support our kids in every possible way.

As 2021 settles into memory and 2022 continues ahead of us, I can't help but feel such luck and privilege to be here in this amazing place and to experience the magic of our Club with our youth. I'm getting to know our community more and more every day, and so many of you have welcomed me with open arms. Thank you for all that you do to ensure Bend's future leaders have consistent, safe spaces to grow into who they are and will become. Thank you for working alongside us all to do whatever it takes for our collective community of youth.

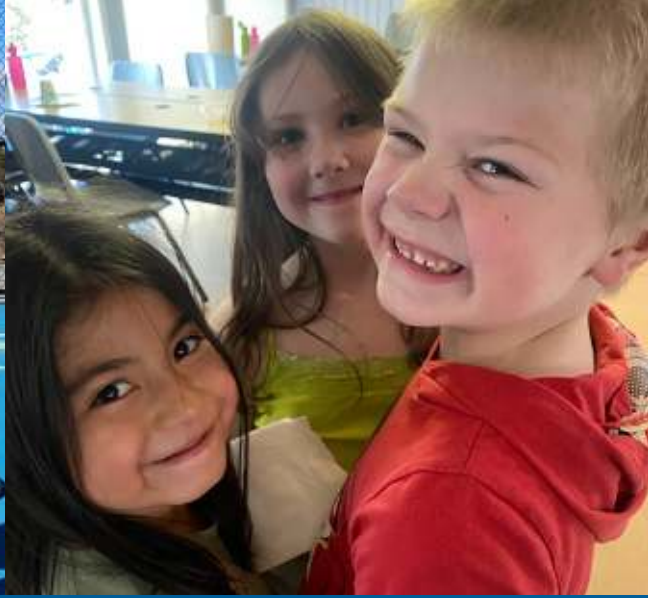

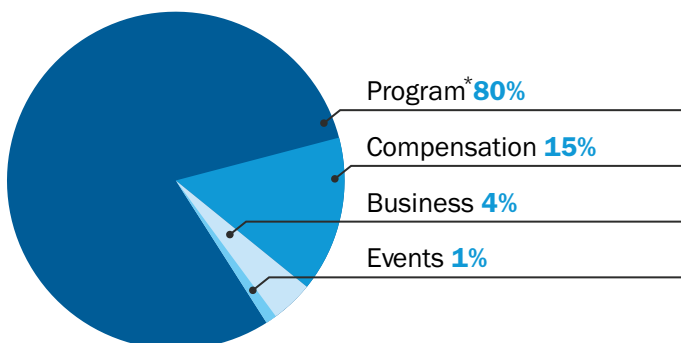

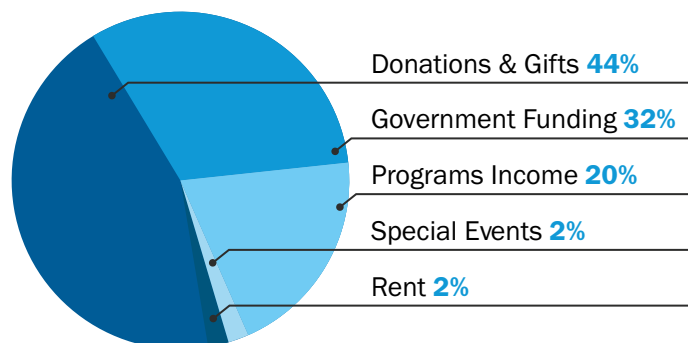
