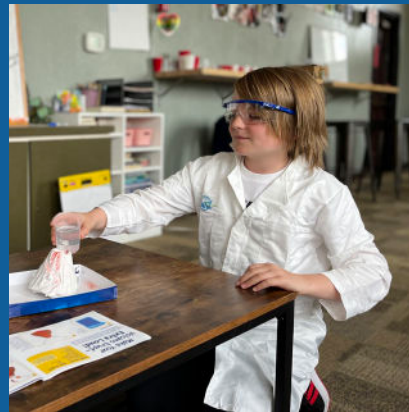

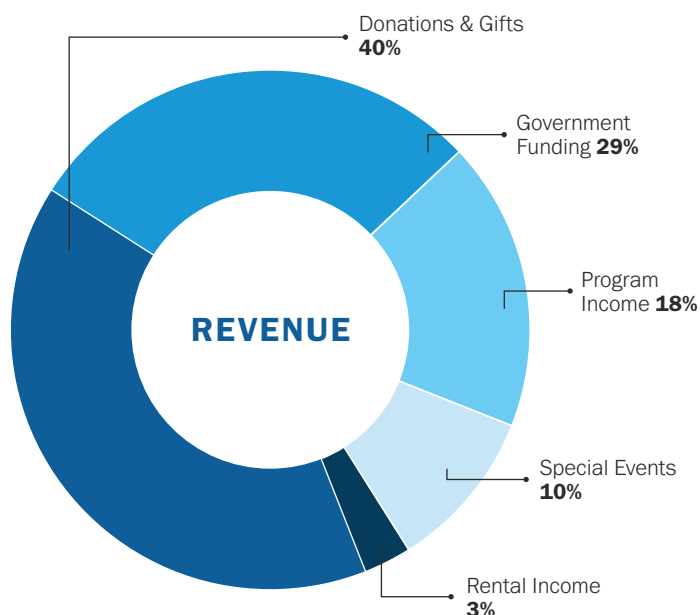
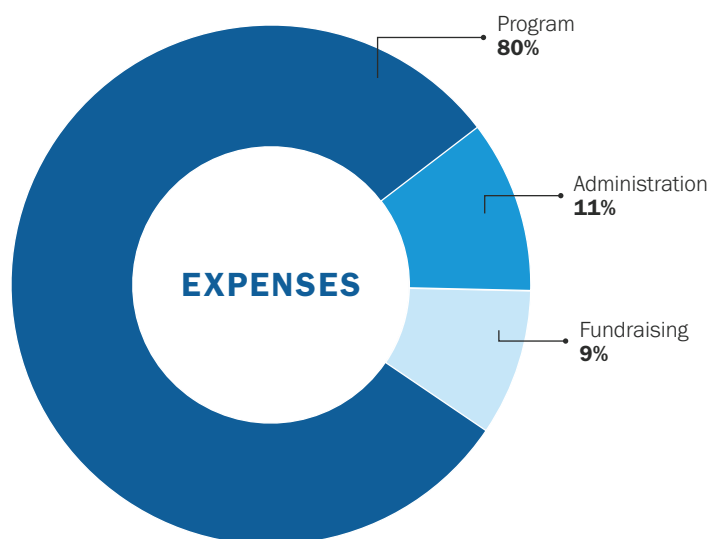

A DAY IN THE LIFE



7:35AM

Mom walks me to the Club before she goes to work. I'm so excited, I get Mom to skip to the front doors with me.

8:15AM

At informal time, I get to choose what to do. I play chess with friends and do a puzzle.

9:00AM

Our group "goes" to Switzerland! We learn about the Swiss Alps, eat Swiss chocolate, and learn how to yodel. I get second place in the yodeling contest!

10:00AM

I love experiments! Our staff (Yes, the members call them "staff.") fill bowls with things like rice, gummy worms, and other stuff birds eat. It's funny to try to pick up things like we had funny bird beak shapes. Now I know why bird beaks aren't all the same and why they evolve. Being a toucan is the funniest!

11:05AM

DEAR means Drop Everything And Read! We can read anything we want, but one of the staff is really good at impersonating book characters, so I want to read in a group. We read the part about the polar bears and I am so excited to finish this book in The Magic Treehouse series.

12:10PM

We get yummy ham and cheese sandwiches and lots of

fruit! Our staff makes sure we walk together to a spot under a tree and play a memory game while we eat.

1:00PM

Today we get to go to Juniper Swim (& Fitness)! Staff check that we all have our swimsuits, and that we are ready to walk to the Club van together. I've been practicing how to tread water, and I'm getting pretty good at it!

2:30PM

We are leaving already? My fingers are wrinkly, and I almost fall asleep in the van on the way back to Club.

3:00PM

I am so hungry I can eat a whole elephant! Staff give out snack and I run over to my favorite spot when we watch movies.

3:15PM

We vote to watch Encanto so we can sing the song "We Don't Talk About Bruno!" from the movie. Some of my friends want to watch Frozen, but they are okay with watching it next Friday.

5:10PM

I give everyone high fives and say bye to Emma at the front desk. Abuelo (Grandpa) is there and I tell him what I learned about bird beaks and yodeled! I'm careful that I don't yodel too loud because I know it hurts his hearing aid.

MISSION MOMENTS

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Bend serves the Bend community, and our after-school and summer programs are offered to all kids (ages 5-18) – especially those who need us most. Our programs support character and leadership development, healthy lifestyles, and academic success. We focus on children with high needs and living in poverty by providing free to low-cost programs to engage in learning, play, and social development.

Throughout 2022, we had the privilege of providing programming for 334 kids. That's 334 unique children, who all have a story to share.

The Boys & Girls Clubs of Bend exists to help empower all youth, families, and staff to reach their full collective potential. We believe in the right for individuals and communities to have equitable access and opportunity to participate and succeed in all organizations and workplaces, particularly our own.



MEET Ashton

Within the first week of attending the Club, we noticed that Ashton*, was overwhelmed by busy environments and would stop being verbally responsive when he was overly stimulated. Our staff immediately noticed these triggers relating to sensory disorders, and Ashton was immediately referred to our Director of Youth & Family Services and paused attending Club.

After some time with a behavioral psychologist and a mental health therapist, a diagnosis and treatment were advised and tailored for Ashton's

specific needs. Our staff used the advised methods from specialists, and not only were they used at Club, but his family was taught how to prevent and manage his overstimulation. We are grateful to our attentive staff for recognizing a potentially harmful situation, and for swiftly directing the family to the care they needed.

Thanks to the help from Family Access Network (FAN), the Bend-La Pine School District, and staff of BGCB, Ashton is set for success.

FAMILY PLUS

The Director of Youth & Family Services at BGCB is a vital position that provides support to Club members, families and staff through four programmatic components: prevention and intervention, family investment and engagement, member and staff support, and community relationships through our Family Plus program.

Through this program, we work with community partners to provide additional services that support many of our Club members in a number of ways, including an increase food security for our Club community.

Each week, The Giving Plate helps us support the nutritional needs of our Club kids by delivering an assortment of food for us to share. Our team puts three unique dinners into

bags for our Club youth who have signed up to receive the meal support. With bags stationed at the front door every Tuesday for families to collect when checking out their children, we inevitably have a Club youth or two inquire about why we have so much food gathered.

Our Membership Services Coordinator always shares the same message: This food is for any Club family that thinks they would benefit from receiving a bag of dinners each week.

MEET Jenny

One young Club member, Jenny*, grew so excited when she learned about the available food bags from The Giving Plate. She asked if she could take home paperwork for her family to sign.

The next day, Jenny returned to Club with her family's signed approval. She was so very proud to have advocated for herself and family, ensuring that they would not go hungry during the week.

Every Monday, with a huge smile on her face, Jenny reminds our Membership Services Coordinator that she will need a meal bag on Tuesday.

The pride and confidence that Jenny exudes each week as she advocates for her family is a prime example of the respect and belonging fostered at Club.
